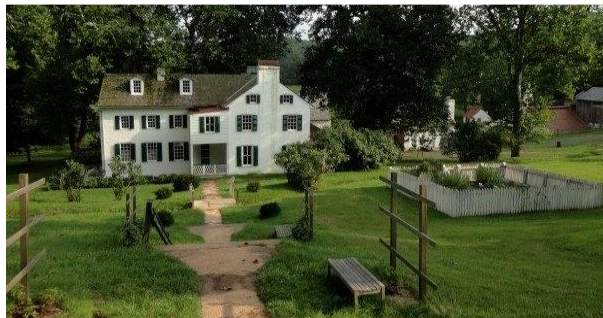
The Friends has supported special events and maintained the gardens, the collections, the library, the costumes, educational activities and interpretation work at the park.
