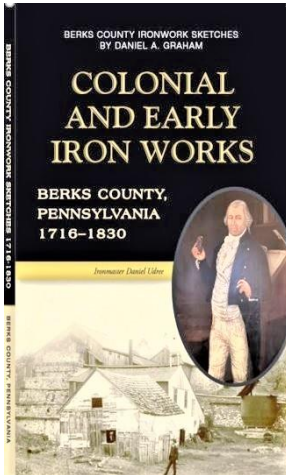

# Colonial And Early Ironworks of Berks County

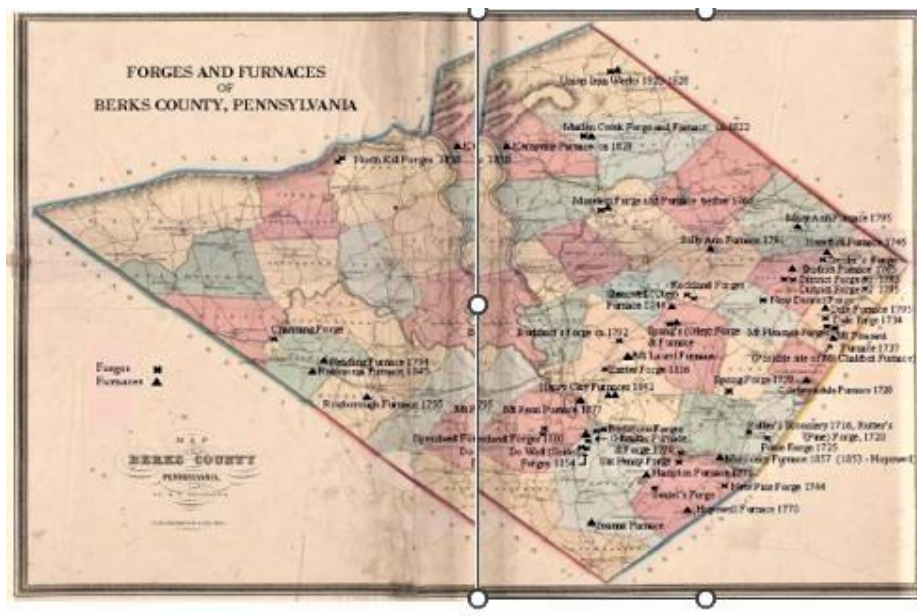
