Documents are organized by general topic and listed in chronological order of preparation in each category.

Documents describing general historical topics about ironmaking and historical physical and cultural setting of the Site are presented in documents in the first section.

A number of documents are concerned with physical condition and historical interpretations of the structures and descriptions of restoration actions taken by NPS.

Some administrative documents concerning the presentation of the furnace operation and life in the village are discussed in several of the documents. Natural resource and cultural resource studies are also presented by topic in a few of the reports.

The Administrative History of Hopewell Furnace NHS presents a thorough narrative of the acquisition of the park property (along with that of current day French Creek State Park) under the French Creek Recreational Demonstration Project in the 1930s, the restoration of the historic structures, assessment of the eras to depict in the park and the work to prepare recreation areas for use.
